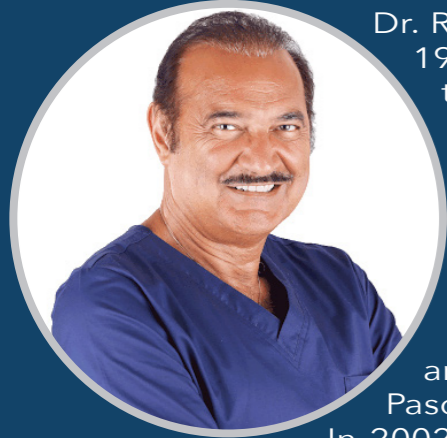

Dr. Roberto Conte, born in Latiano (BR) IN 1952, obtained his degree in medicine at the University of Padua in 1977, while he was licensed to practice professionally the following year. He was registered as Surgeon in the local professional register in Padua from 1978, and as a Dentist from 1990.

In 1990 he began his practice as implantologist, following the teaching and techniques of Tramonte, Muratori, Pasqualini, Linkow and finally Branemark.

In 2002 he obtained the postgraduate title in Implantology at the University of New York, discussing a thesis on the pterigoyd implant. In 1996, at the same University he took part in several studies and conferences on the pterigoyd implant. Since 1999, alongside prof. Moren, he performed and led courses on cadaver at the University Claude Bernard Lyon 1, at the same time studying and personalizing his own surgical protocol for the insertion of pterigoyd implants. In 2006 he obtained his degree in implantological anatomy at the University Claude Bernard Lyon 1. Lecturer of the specialization course in implantological anatomy at the University Jean Monnet in Saint'Etienne since 2010, that same year he became Clinical Coordinator for the "NYU Tutor project" in Italy, and obtained his Master in Implantology Zigmatics at the University of Pisa.

PROGRAM

THEORETICAL SESSION

- Bone anatomy of the craniofacial district;
- Models of bone resorption and anatomical limits;
- Innervation of the oral district and alveolar nerve
- Mental foramen and incisal canal;
- Type of bone (D1-D2-D3-D4) and suggested surgical approaches;
- Vascularization of the oral district and main vessels on the floor of the mouth;
- Post-extractive dental implants;
- Minor Sinus Lift, according to Summer's technique, with osteotomes;
- Greenstick fracture (split crest);
- Major Maxillary Sinus Lift;
- Soft tissues harvesting and grafts;
- Suturing techniques.

Practical cadaver dissection exercises for the participants, in the structures of the University of Saint'Etienne (France). Main purposes of the Practice: **the goal of these activities is to lead the participants to acquire higher manual skills in the implant placement.**

Dissection and anatomical study: Maxilla

- Infraorbital foramen;
- Greater palatine artery;
- Incisal canal;
- Infraorbital nerve;
- Maxillary Sinus.

Dissection and anatomical study: Mandible

- Mandibular symphysis;
- Mental foramen;
- Mylohyoid line;
- Cortico-medullary bone sampling.

Exercises in the execution of various flap techniques

- Incisions;
- Various techniques for detaching the flaps;
- Periosteal release;
- Samples from the palate and grafts (for esthetic surgery in frontal sectors).

Suturing techniques

- From the simplest to the most complex suturing techniques

- Malò technique for the ALL-ON-FOUR

Mandible
